The Compostela Group of Universities received placement offers from 12 members for the mobility programme STELLA Junior.

These universities submitted 30 placement offers through the online form, which will offer those interested training experiences in international relations departments, research or in centers that provide support for students with functional diversity, among others.

All the offers have already been published on the [STELLA Junior](#) programme page on the Compostela Group website, after having been confirmed by the Higher Education institutions that submitted them.

With the publication of the list offers, the CGU has opened the call for applications for the 6 grants awarded by the network. These grants have an economic allocation of 650 euros each and applications must be submitted until 28 February 2019. STELLA Junior grant shall be compatible with any other mobility grant unless stated otherwise by others.

Once the deadline for the submission of applications has expired, a Selection Committee will be in charge of deciding on the beneficiaries of the granted mobility.
