CGU receives almost a hundred applications for the mobility programme STELLA for Staff

Candidates from 38 members of the Compostela Group of Universities and the Consortium for North American Higher Education Collaboration (CONAHEC) submitted their applications for STELLA for Staff.

The Executive Secretariat of the Compostela Group of Universities received 98 applications for its professional mobility programme for services staff, of which two were submitted after the deadline and will not be reviewed by the Selection Committee.

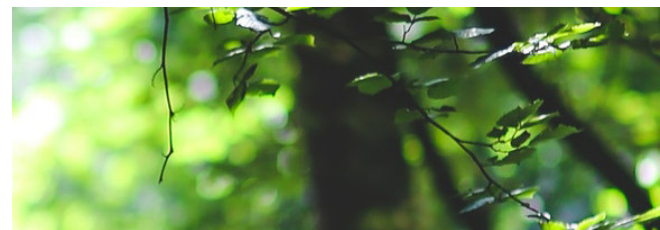
Submission of applications

TWO VOLUNTEER PERIODS

- FIRST period. From 10th July to 10th August 2019.
- SECOND period. From 10th August to 10th September 2019.

The Compostela Group of Universities (CGU) and the Asociación de Municipios del Camino de Santiago launch the youth volunteer programme University Walking Community, which will run from July to September 2019 in various municipalities of the French Route.

The aim of the programme, in which Diputación de Huesca collaborates, is to help university community to volunteer on the Camino de Santiago. For that purpose, both associations will select 40 students who will be awarded a grant to participate in this first call of University Walking Community. This grant includes a volunteer training course and accommodation, meals and local transport during the period of voluntary work.
