Development since CGU's 20th General Assembly

What is it about?

- Near consensus as regards the cost of corruption
- UN Convention against Corruption - “a non-tolerance of corruption”
- Yet. we seldom see components of ethics and anti-corruption within higher education
- A call for mainstreaming of anti-corruption across disciplines in higher education

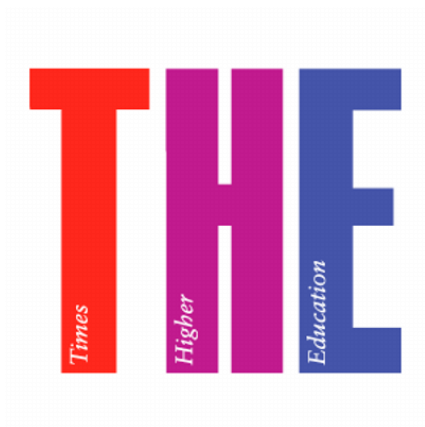
